



Now that the 57th Legislative Session is over at the Arizona State House of Representatives, it is not only wise, but necessary to take a breather and look back at our great successes and accomplishments before we look and move ahead. This will ensure future successes as we learn from our past.

Policy Priorities & Goals

If there is one thing that I have learned in the last six months, is that together, we accomplish more for Arizona and with your support our future looks brighter than ever.

Let's take a look at the progress we have made so far:

January: We had the swearing-in ceremony for the 57th Legislative Session. I was elected as Majority Leader. We introduced the [2025 Majority Plan](#).

February: Several important bills started making their way through the legislative process. They reflect our commitment to championing conservative values and improving the lives of Arizonans. They aligned with the Majority Plan.

March: I sponsored bills like [HB2450](#), [HB2672](#), and [HB2448](#) that would promote conservative values.

April: I supported bills like [HB2099](#), [HB2112](#), [HB2126](#) and [HB2164](#).

May: I announced my run for re-election. We continued working hard on drafting a conservative and fiscally responsible budget.

June: We passed a state budget unanimously at the State House. This budget reflects our commitment to fiscal responsibility, focusing on limited government, reducing wasteful spending, and protecting taxpayer dollars.

Here are some of the major wins:

- ✓ \$100 million reduction in spending in budget window
- ✓ \$100 million less gimmicks: PDRF reduced from \$150M to \$100M in '27 and '28
- ✓ Budget includes Auditor General funding plus 11 new auditors; Gov agreed to sign HB2369 to allow OAG access to accounting record of county audits
 - Prevent another Santa Cruz County style theft of taxpayer monies
 - OAG provided resources it needs for special audits
- ✓ Responding to explosive growth in Developmental Disabilities program
 - No longer can exec deny Legislature key data
 - New reporting requirements on utilization by service category
 - Requires key data breaking out state spending by disability category
- ✓ DD group home monitoring pilot shortened by 3 years
 - Exec wanted 5 years, amended to 2 years
 - Pilot program and funding goes exclusively towards activist lobbying entity
- ✓ Runway train in School Facilities Division stopped
 - Prevents next "alt-fuels" type scandal
 - Governor's School Facilities Division at ADOA recently adopted a new pilot program: End of Useful Life
 - Sent a bill to legislature for \$8m in new spending
 - This "pilot" could easily balloon to a 9 figure number
 - Exec agreed to curtail this program, pilot may only approve up to \$10m next year
- ✓ Spouses of Law Enforcement Scholarship Fund now permanent law (higher ED BRB)
 - First \$500k available in \$10m fund for Mil Spouses will go to this fund
 - Estimated to cover current demand
- ✓ Public safety grants for information sharing [FIMS & RMS] \$5m
- ✓ \$3.5m for SR 303/155th Ave Interchange Design Costs
- ✓ \$850k Olga Road Pavement Preservation/Rehabilitation Design Costs
- ✓ Resisted new demands by Exec for ESA cuts or changes


