HB2126:

Requires a healthcare entity, while maintaining required confidentiality, to provide the parent of a minor child with access to any electronic portal and delivery platform for the minor's medical records, regardless of whether parental consent is required for the medical treatment rendered.

This Bill is important to our District and Arizona because it ensures that parents have access to their child's medical records, even if they do not have consent for treatment. This is crucial for parents to be able to make informed decisions about their child's healthcare and overall well-being.

It also allows for a better continuation of care, as parents will have access to important medical information in case of emergency or when switching healthcare providers.

Additionally, this Bill addresses the issue of confidentiality by stating that the healthcare entity must maintain required confidentiality while still providing access to the parent. This protects both the privacy of the minor and the parent's right to know about their child's medical history.
